**One who is just will live in the presence of the Lord.**

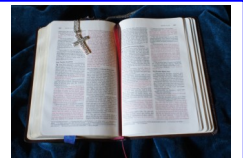
He does not give his money in hope of gain, nor does he take a bribe against the innocent. Whoever does these things shall never be overthrown.

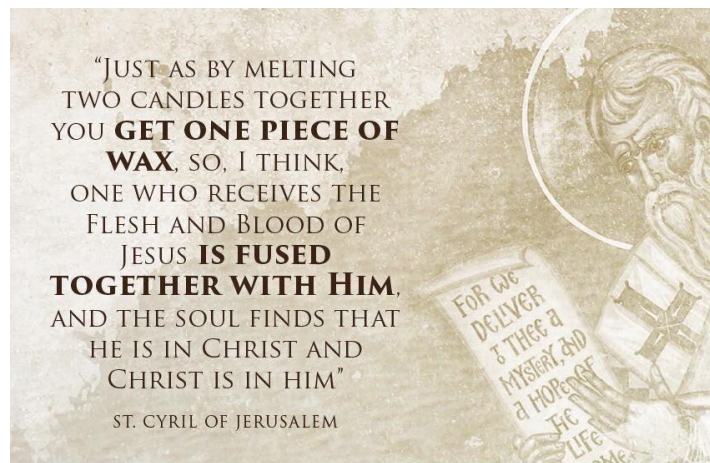

The Charity Shop in Academy Street brings in much needed income to the Black Isle Charge but it relies on volunteers to keep it going.

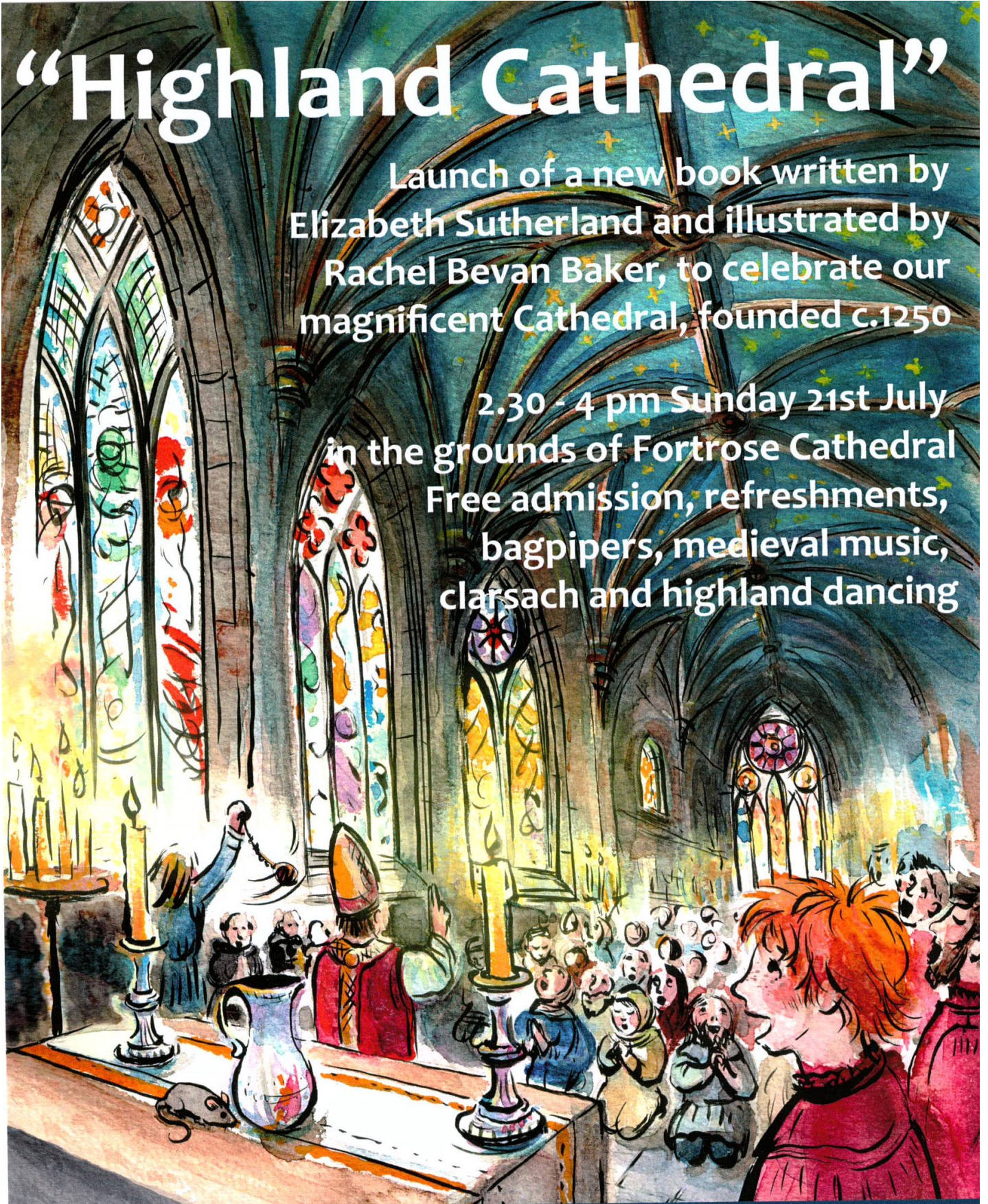
Not only does it generate income but it provides a focal point for locals and visitors alike.
