Cromarty Advent Window Trail

This Christmas Season, Cromarty Sunday Club along with the congregations of St Regulus and West Church, are hoping to bring some Christmas Cheer to Cromarty by creating an Advent Window Trail.

In the early evening of 1st December, the first of 25 windows appeared. From then on every day a new window appeared, as we create a living Advent Calendar and a Trail that will weave its way colourfully through Cromarty. The final windows will be revealed on Christmas Eve, when you will have 2 to look out for, just like the double doors you often find at No. 24 on an Advent calendar.

The windows are made using black card and coloured tissue paper. When they are placed in a window, a light is placed behind them giving a stained-glass window effect. Each involved household was assigned a part of the Nativity story to be incorporated in their window, but there will be lots of other Christmassy features as well.

As we go through December, the Christmas story will unfold. The organisers hope to give the people of Cromarty something to enjoy and look forward to each day, particularly as this is going to be quite a different Christmas for many of us.

The hope of the Advent Trail is that we generate conversation and give everyone something good to talk about. From Christmas Eve, you will also be able to download the route and follow it all around town. The windows will stay up until Sunday 3rd January 2021.
